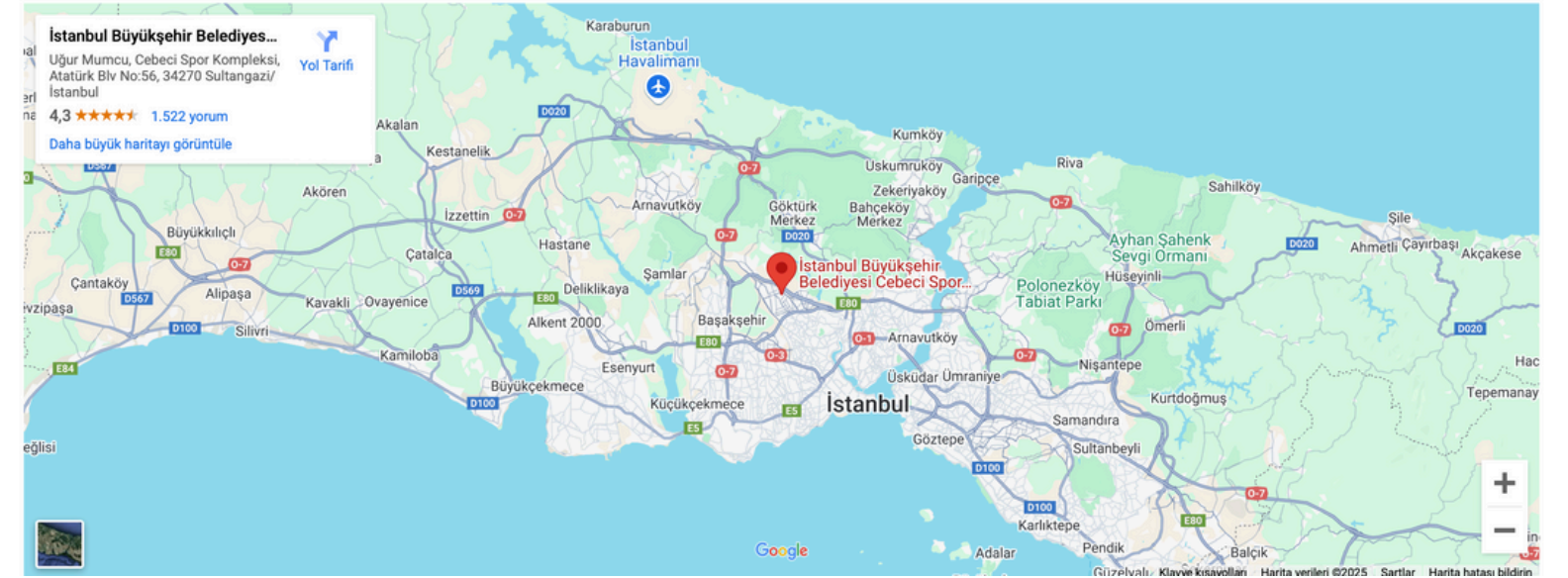

VENUE

The Cebeci Sports Complex (Cebeci Spor Kompleksi) is a multi-purpose sports facility located in the Cebeci neighbourhood of central Istanbul, Türkiye.

Here are some key details about the venue:

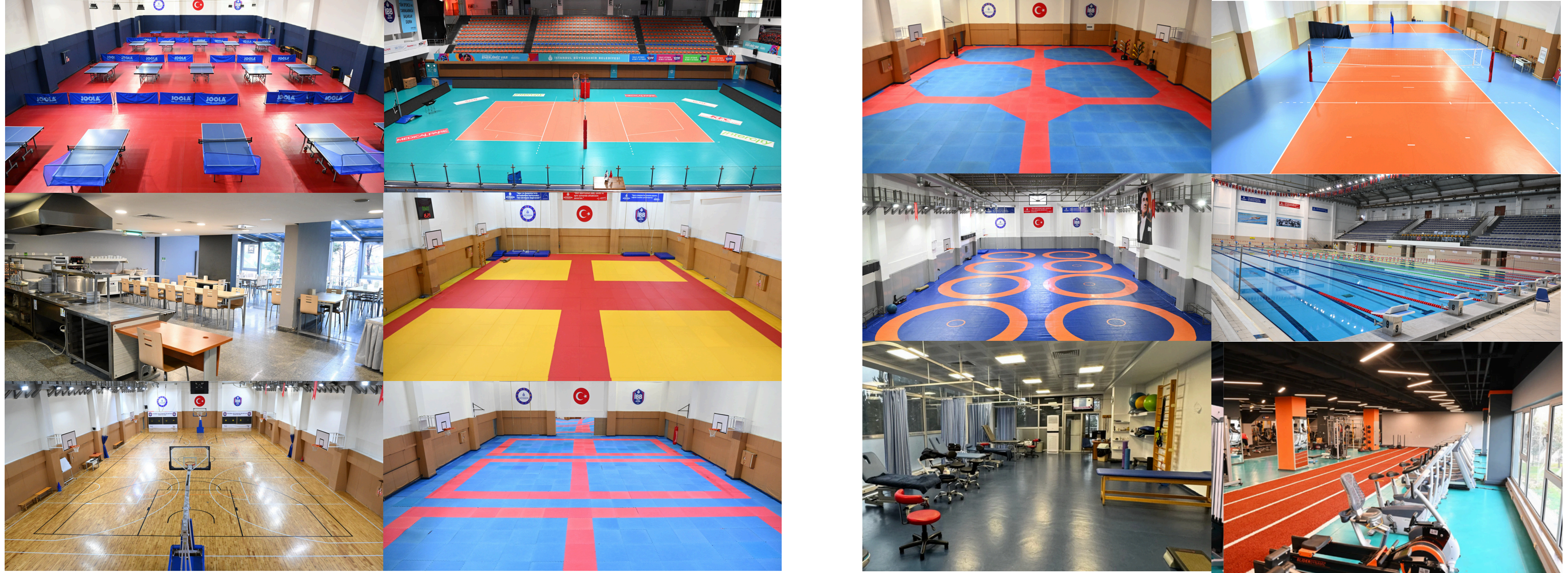
Track and Field Venue: The complex includes standard-size athletics track with six-lane, making it suitable for athletics events and trainings.

Indoor Sports Facilities: There are indoor halls within the complex for a variety of indoor sports, such as swimming, basketball, volleyball, taekwondo, judo, table tennis.

Fitness and Recreation: The complex is designed for community use, with recreational spaces for both individuals and groups. These areas are typically equipped with gyms, fitness rooms, and other resources for general wellness and sports training.

ACCOMMODATION

The Kanuni Sultan Süleyman Dormitory will be used as the accommodation facility for all teams. LOC will create a village of comfortable standard and well-equipped hotel standard rooms with various activities.

There will be single and double rooms to suit all needs.

LOC will organize the rooms as accessible as possible. Accommodation is included in the entry fee. The same price category will be applied to all levels of accommodation.

Nations are requested to submit their rooming list, and LOC will finalize all accommodation arrangements.

TRANSPORTATION

A sufficient number of buses will be scheduled according to the number of participants and flight schedules. The LOC will provide a welcome service for participants at the airport. Airport transfers for delegations will be organised with LOC buses. WC-friendly buses will be planned according to the number of wheelchair participants. A well-prepared shuttle service will also be provided for the participants between accommodation facilities and venues.

CATERING

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are included in the entry fee. We will cater to all special dietary needs. The meals will be planned well for the athletes and a food engineer will be on duty during the Games to inspect all catering preparations.

MEDICAL SERVICES

The LOC will provide a medical team and a fully equipped ambulance at the Cebeci Sport Facility and accommodation facilities between 21-28 July 2025. The LOC's partner hospitals will be no more than 20 minutes away.

DOPING CONTROL

An anti-doping programme will be carried out working with the relevant organisations.

VISA

Ordinary and official passport holders from European countries are exempted from visas. Only participants from Cyprus and Armenia are required to have a visa to enter Türkiye.

We would like to submit for the participants who need the visa that the Electronic Visa (e-Visa) Application System was launched on 17 April 2013 by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Türkiye. This system allows visitors travelling to Türkiye to easily obtain their e-Visas online (www.evisa.gov.tr), in approximately three minutes.

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

There must be at least 4 athletes or teams competing in order for an event to be approved as a Medal Event at the start time.

Events not complying with these criteria will be combined and be upgraded to a Medal Event or will be competed as a Non-Medal Event.

The LOC reserves the right to combine age groups and sport classes.

Age Eligibility

Athletes must be between 12 and 23 years old to participate. Please refer to the sport-specific age categories outlined in the following sections for further details.

Entry Requirements

Only NPCs in good standing with the European Paralympic Committee are eligible to register athletes for EPYG 2025. Participating athletes must hold the nationality of the NPC registering them.

Sport-specific registration must also be completed through the respective federation's registration channels.

SPORTS

The Sport Programme, developed by the LOC and endorsed by the EPC and IFs, will feature the following disciplines:

Para Athletics, Para Archery, Boccia, Para Judo, Goalball, Para Swimming, Para Table tennis, Para Taekwondo, and Wheelchair Basketball.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is €180 per person per day. The total amount is €1.260 for each participant for the 21-28 July 2025.

The additional cost for a single room is 60€ per person per day. The fee covers accommodation, full board meals (from lunch and dinner on the arrival day to breakfast on the departure day), ceremonies, event transportation, supporting events and the Discovery Programme.

IMPORTANT DATES:

The LOC must receive the invoiced amounts in full. This means that all bank fees are the responsibility of the payer. After the entry, the LOC will be available to assist supporters and families in the process of participating in the Games (accommodation). Registration must also be done through the respective sports' own channels. Further details will be provided later

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

- * For any cancellation the 30st of April to the 30th of May, the reimbursement is 50% of the personal entry fee.
- * From the 31st of May to the 20st of June the reimbursement is 30% of the personal entry fee.
- * No reimbursement will be paid later than 20st of June.
- * After entry cancellation is possible only with a medical certificate/report.
